The following items are MANDATORY for students receiving funding and affiliated with CBBG:

- Database Profile:** Keep your Database profile up to date (in case you are unfamiliar with the platform, contact your PI) <https://cbbg.engineering.asu.edu/cbbg-database/>
- BioGeotechNotes:** Review weekly BioGeotechNotes email, typically sent out every Tuesday by Emma Buchanan (if you are not getting these, please email Emma Buchanan egbuchan@mainex1.asu.edu)
- Newsletter:** Read and/or contribute to the quarterly CBBG newsletter
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):** Sign (and abide by) the CBBG Faculty/Senior Researcher/Student MOU each year
- Confidentiality Agreement:** Sign (and abide by)
- Outreach:** Participate in at least one outreach event each semester (minimum 2 per year)
- Webinars:** Attend all webinars or view recordings (unless otherwise noted)
- Mentoring:** Mentor at least one student (undergraduate/high school student or K-14 teacher/student) during the summer and/or academic year. Talk to your advisor about opportunities at your campus.
- SLC Activities:** Participate in SLC activities, which includes the Mid-year and Annual Meeting, student events, workshops, etc.
- Evaluation:** Respond to questionnaires and surveys in a timely fashion
